

SOCIAL SERVICES PROGRAMME

1st SEMESTER

Introduction to Social Services

This course focuses on the fundamental principles of social services and to the major subjects of social services inquiry.

Introduction to Psychology

This course focuses on the fundamental principles of psychology and to the major subjects of psychological inquiry.

Introduction to Sociology

Students will understand sociological concepts and they can improve their own sociological imagination.

Social and Cultural Structure of Turkey

This course focuses on understanding of social and cultural structure of turkey since Ottoman Empire to now a days.

AHP 214- First Aid 3 ECTS

First aid entry and general characteristics, evaluation of basic life function, respiratory and circulatory system, first aid injury, bleeding in first aid, shock and first aid, buns and first aid, poisoning and first aid, fracture-dislocations and sprains first aid, basic life support.

Ataturk's Principles and History of Turkish Revolution I 2 ECTS

Teaching the military, political, economic and social events of the Ottoman Empire in the internal and external politics, the struggle for national liberation and the formation of the new Turkish Republic.

English I 2 ECTS

Students will understand English effectively and use basic grammar of English Rules. Through this course, students will be able to interpret simple dialogues in English and use the new structures and words they have learned in their daily lives.

TURK 111 - Turkish Language I 2 ECTS

2nd SEMESTER

Theory in Social Service

This course focuses on the different social service theory and students will understand different social services approaches from critical perspectives.

Social Problems

This course focuses on social problems and the solutions to problems related with families, schools, workplaces, communities, and the environment.

Migration and Social Service

This course will be on the identification of social work, be aware of the migrant groups.

Legal Regulations on social service

This course focuses on the legal system that informs social services practice.

Social service foundations

This course focuses on the history and demographics of culturally diverse groups, including family and community diversity.

Interviewing Techniques in Social Services

This courses focuses on the quantitative and qualitative research methods, the research process, and the role of research in professional practice.

Ataturk's Principles and History of Turkish Revolution II 2 ECTS

3rd SEMESTER

Human behavior in the social work environment 1

This course focuses on the developmental stages of the individual from infancy to adolescence.

Social Service Management

This course focuses the social service management in the context of social services and processes, concepts of organization management in social services.

Compulsory Internship I 4 ECTS

The professional knowledge gained at the school, students will receive internships during the thirty working days at the end of the 2nd semester to ensure that they acquire new practical and technical skills, to acquire business skills, and to communicate effectively with other disciplines and administrators.

4th SEMESTER

Human behavior in the social work environment 2

This course focuses on the developmental stages of the individual from young adult to age.

Substance Abuse and social services

This course help students on social work practice regarding methods for prevention, identification, treatment of persons with alcohol and other drug related problem.

Sign language

This course focuses on the fundamental elements of sign language.

Women studies and social services

This course helps to analyze gender theory and researches about woman studies.

Anthropology

This course focuses on history of cultural anthropology and research of changing theoretical and methodological approaches.

Media and social services

This course focuses on a perspective on significant dimensions of social stratification and gender of various forms of media.
