COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

1st SEMESTER

<u>ÇGP111- Child Development I 5 | ECTS</u>

Students will be able to asses child development, developmental processes of children, physical, motor, language and cognitive development of children.

<u>ÇGP112- Special Education I | 4 ECTS</u>

Basic concepts related to special education, the overall aim of special education, principles of special education, identification and classification of visually impaired, hearing impaired and speech and language difficulties, disability prevention and early diagnosis.

<u>ÇGP113- Child Health And Diseases | 3 ECTS</u></u>

Child health problems in our country, is common in children findings of some infectious disease, infectious diseases, pre-school education at school and at home, primary preventive measures that can be taken to prevent chronic childhood diseases and raise awareness on behalf of the family to an early warning.

ÇGP114- Children and Play | 3 ECTS

Description of the game, history of the game, game features and benefits of a child of the game, games related to theories and theorists , phases of the game, toy selection, ,game action and group work

<u>CGP115- Communication With Children | 3 ECTS</u>

Effective communication techniques with children, effective communication between family and child, effective communication techniques with family, business communication, techniques for effective communication with staff.

ILK111- First Aid | 3 ECTS

First aid entry and general characteristics, evaluation of basic life function, respiratory and circulatory system, first aid injury, bleeding in first aid, shock and first aid, burns and first aid, poisoning and first aid, fracture-dislocations and sprains first aid, basic life support

MSE111- Occupational Ethics | 3 ECTS

This course will help students learn about the ethical concept and health professional ethics and find solutions to the problems they face in their professional life.

ATA111- Atatürk's Principles And History Of Turkish Revolution I | 2 ECTS

Teaching the military, political, economic and social events of the Ottoman Empire in the internal and external politics, the struggle for national liberation and the formation of the new Turkish Republic.

ING114- English I | 2 ECTS

Students will understand English effectively and use basic grammar of English Rules. Through this course, students will be able to interpret simple dialogues in English and use the new structures and words they have learned in their daily lives.

TURK111- Turkish Language I | 2 ECTS

To give information about language definition, role and importance in communication, verbal and written expression techniques in literary and scientific fields, writing rules and expression disorders.

2nd SEMESTER

<u>**ÇGP121- Child Development II | 4 ECTS</u>**</u>

Personality development, social development, emotional development, sexual development, moral development processes.

<u>ÇGP122- Special Education II | 4 ECTS</u>

Diagnosis and classification of physical disabilities, mental retardation, developmental disorders, gifted children, causes of physical disability, mental retardation, down syndrome, prevention and early diagnosis, training

<u>CGP123- Child Psychology And Mental Health | 3 ECTS</u>

The lesson includes history of child psychology and mental health, detailed explanations of developmental, emotional and behavioral problems of childhood, the diagnosis of abnormal in child psychology, and how to work with each problem.

<u>CGP124- Mother And Child Nutrition | 3 ECTS</u>

Food items, Definition and importance of adequate and balanced diet ,Food of groups , Pregnancy and lactation nutrition , 0-6 months baby nutrition , 6-12 months baby nutrition , 1-2 years old child nutrition , Pre-school term , School children nutrition , Adolescence (11-18 years old) nutrition , Diseases caused by nutritional deficiencies , Food additives , Food allergies

Material Development In Preschool Education | 5 ECTS

This course is meant to support the thoughtful selection of equipment and materials as part of efforts to increase the quality of child care programming experienced by young children. The aim of this course is to develop the skills of designing, developing and evaluating various educational tools, puppets for preschool children.

ÇGP126- Children And Drama | 3 ECTS

The course examines basic concepts of drama in early childhood education, drama activities, teacher's role in drama activities evaluation, role playing technique, pantomime technique, educational drama for mentally handicapped children.

Child Literature And Media | 2 ECTS

The history and aim of the child literature, the features and aims of child books, choising the child book suitable to the child's age, developmental outcomes, telling stories for children, preparing child book and magazines.

ATA121- Atatürk's Principles And History Of Turkish Revolution II | 2 ECTS

This course examines Atatürk's principles and reforms and the political developments after the Ataturk with the establishment process of the Republic of Turkey.

ING 121 - English II | 2 ECTS

Students will be able to understand English, use it effectively and compare basic grammar rules of English. Through this course, students can comment on simple dialogues in English and use the new structures and words they have learned in their daily lives.

TURK 121 - Turkish Language II | 2 ECTS

Proper use of punctuation marks in writing, development of plain text writing skills, listening and reading skills are taught.

3rd SEMESTER

<u>CGP211- Preschool Educational Practice I | 8 ECTS</u></u>

The professional knowledge gained at the school, students will receive internships at the end of the 2nd semester to ensure that they acquire new practical and technical skills, to acquire business skills, and to communicate effectively with other disciplines and administrators at the preschool institutions.

<u>ÇGP212- Compulsory Internship | 5 ECTS</u>

The professional knowledge gained at the school, students will receive internships during the thirty working days at the end of the 2nd semester to ensure that they acquire new practical and technical skills, to acquire business skills, and to communicate effectively with other disciplines and administrators.

Children's Art And Creativity | 5 ECTS

The course aims to teach creativity and intelligence in relation to creativity and intelligence, to develop creativity in children, to encourage teacher candidates to discover their creativity, to

understand the development of aesthetic perception in children and to develop graphic activities, to introduce materials used in art activities, to develop artistic activities and creative materials suitable for educational purposes.

CGP214- Program Development In Preschool Education | 4 ECTS

The aim of this course is; the student to be able to define concepts related to program development, to be able to grasp the elements and to implement the principles related to the planning of the teaching.

<u>ÇGP215- Classroom Management | 3 ECTS</u>

Classroom communication and interaction, definition of classroom management, different aspects and characteristics of classroom management, classroom environment, classroom management models, development and application of classroom rules, management of unwanted behaviors in class, time management in class, class organization, creating a positive classroom environment suitable for learning (examples and suggestions).

ÇGP216- Children And Music |2 ECTS

The importance of auditory perception and music, music development in childhood, music techniques used in childhood music studies, listening and distinguishing sound, singing, creative movement and dance, rhythm, musical narratives, preparation of music programs to support children with disabilities and hospitalized children

ÇGP217- Values Education | 2 ECTS

During training, the students not only an understanding of the cognitive and psycho - motor gains given, but also the individuals that make up society, values, attitudes, etc. will result in failing to acquire affective gains, the meaning and place of values in children's life.

BIL221- Information And Communication Technology |4 ECTS

Use computer at basic level (preparing documents, preparing tables, preparing presentations, using internet).

Family Education | 3 ECTS

To provide School-Family Cooperation in Early Childhood Education, family participation activities, methods and techniques used in family education, types and activities of communication with family will be covered by sample sessions and the theories of School-Family Cooperation will be evaluated.

Child Assessment Techniques | 3 ECTS

The basic knowledge about the methods and techniques of recognition and evaluation of children, to give students the competencies related to developmental evaluation in accordance with the developmental characteristics, standard and non-standard techniques.
